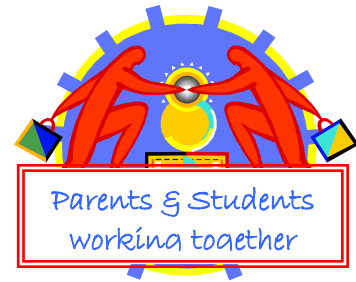


**MHS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM
