## **Foundation Provides Support for Marshall Area Schools**

The Pride in the Tiger Foundation approved over \$20,000 in grants for the Marshall area schools throughout the 2007-2008 school year. The grants awarded are as follows:

\$750 for Holy Redeemer's Missoula Children's Theater  
• Directors for Missoula Children's Theater held auditions for approximately 60 parts. Students and directors rehearsed 4 nights and performed a play for their parents and the Marshall community.

\$1,931 to Parkside Elementary • This project brought in storyteller, Sean Brown for a two week residency. The students participated in a variety of activities including visualizations, character interviews, drawing, writing movement, voice work and acting. All of these areas are critical in the development of reading, which is the central focus of first grade.

\$2,000 to the Marshall High School • Listen, Learn and Succeed Project for 9th Grade English classrooms. This was used to purchase audio books and equipment. This was used to enhance and promote reading.

\$2,000 to Marshall Middle School • This allowed for the purchase of novels that will be used for literature circles in 5th grade Language Arts classes.

\$1,500 to Parkside Elementary • This covered partial cost of a smart board in Mrs. Pack's first grade classroom. Mrs. Planned to use the smart board to bring the visual retention of special needs students to a high point and thus learning has improved greatly with these students.

\$1400 to help cover expenses of the Senior Banquet. Students are awarded scholarships at the Senior Banquet.

\$400 to Marshall Middle School • This allowed the 7th grade class to attend "A Christmas Carol." The class read the play prior to the performance.

\$1,500 to Parkside Elementary • This covered partial cost of a portable smart board that has been placed into the first grade classrooms.

\$500 to Marshall Middle School • This provided funding which allowed the 8th grade class to attend the Festival of Nations and the Minnesota Science Museum.

\$800 to Marshall High School • This provided funding which allowed the implementation of a program that united SMSU and MHS students in efforts to increase success of second language learners.

\$1,500 to Marshall Middle School • This allowed for the purchase of fiction and non-fiction that will be used for 5th and 6th grade English Language Learners.

\$400 Lutheran Social Services • To help cover expenses of the Foster Grandparent program.

\$4,000 to Marshall Wrestling Boosters • This helped fund the youth wrestling program.
